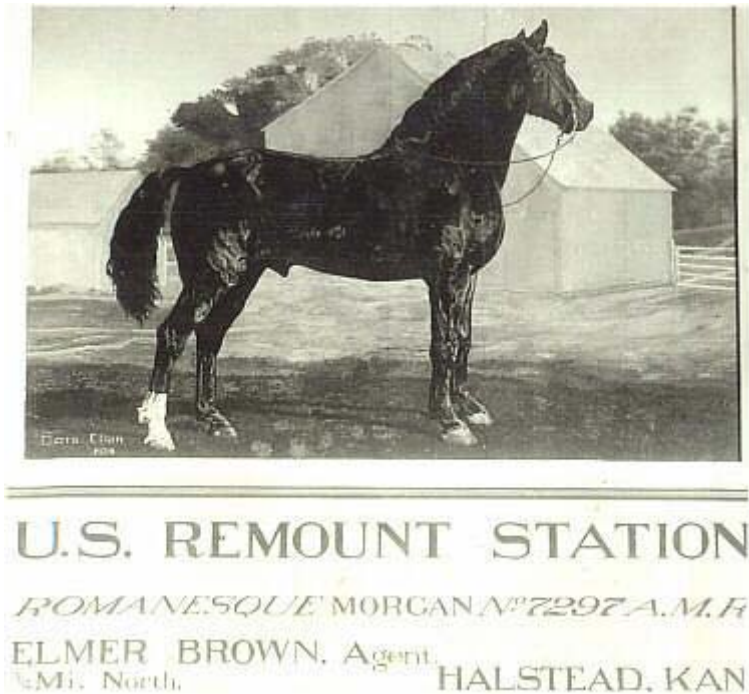


ROMANESQUE MORGAN No. 7297 A.M.R.

Foaled on May Day of 1921, a chestnut colt would be registered with a visually dramatic name, a name that might be hard to live up to. He did in fact grow into every corner of it and in as big a way as the name commanded. 67 offspring had he and those that bred on respectably ensconced their sire in the pedigrees of many great WWF Morgans.
